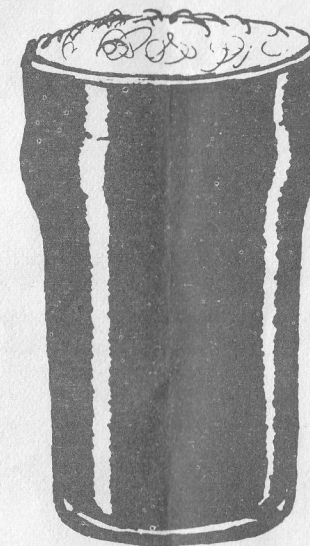

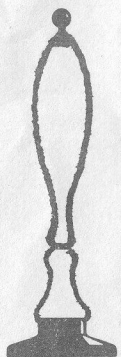


OFFICIAL SOUVENIR PROGRAMME - FREE

It's thanks largely to CAMRA, through events such as this and the bigger national "Great British Beer Festival", held at Alexandra Palace every year, that 'real ale' is making such a comeback all over the country after virtual extinction, but we couldn't have done this without the help of many more discerning drinkers, so help us to continue the fight by making sure that next time you go into a pub, don't just settle for keg or lager, but demand real ale, or better still, join the campaign officially (see back page). 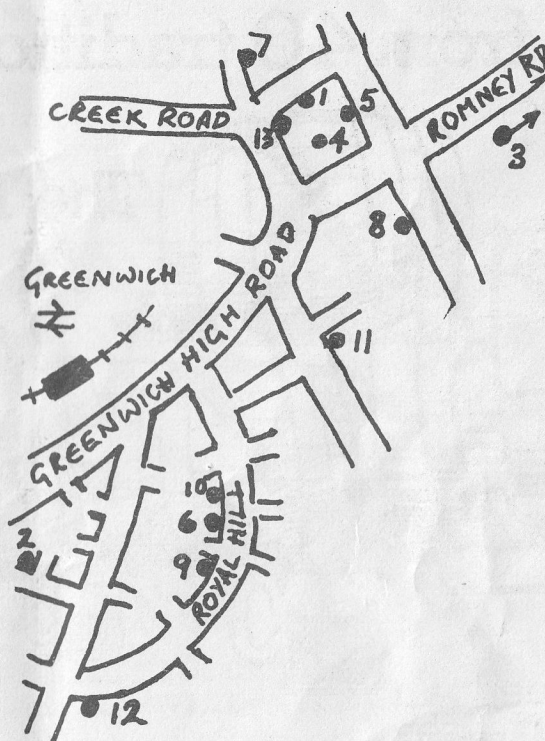
