

South East London CAMRA – Branch Cider Pub of the Year Selection Process

- Each year, Branch members are invited to nominate a pub(s) for consideration;
- The Branch Cider Rep will arrange to survey the nominated pubs along with any branch members who wish to attend. The judging criteria will be the same as that used for the London Regional Cider Pub of the Year judging.
- Discussions between all attendees will arrive at a mutually agreed score for each criteria. All scores will then be totalled to determine a final overall score for each pub. The highest scoring pub is declared the winner and in due course will be awarded a branch Cider Pub of the Year certificate;
- Unless there are exceptional circumstances, any pub that wins the award for two consecutive years is ineligible for the following year's competition but becomes eligible again the year after.

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
